



The UTRF Technology Maturation Grant program is an annual grant competition providing UT faculty, staff, and students with funding of up to \$15,000 to develop technologies with commercial potential.

GUIDELINES

- Open to all UT researchers, faculty, staff and students at all campuses and institutes.
- Projects must be related to an existing UT invention disclosure, OR a proposal can be accompanied by a new UT invention/creation disclosure.

To submit a disclosure visit: idea.tennessee.edu

- All proposals should clearly respond to the questions presented in the proposal application and provide a strong case for the commercial readiness of an idea or technology.
- Proposals that only generate basic research results will not be funded.
- Identification of potential commercial partners for collaboration on this proposal is encouraged.

Proposals must be received by your campus research office (through Evisions) by 5:00 p.m. on 10/24/19. Do not submit directly to UTRF.

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

NEW FORMAT: Please download and complete the <u>UTRF Technology Maturation Grant Proposal</u> application. Other forms of submission will not be accepted!

Proposals should answer questions concerning:

- 1) Project Description
- 2) Specific Aims
- 3) Expected Outcome and Impact
- 4) Budget and Budget Justification
- Proposals should not exceed 2 pages, excluding references and figures. One page of references and one page of figures may be included as appendices.
- Proposals plus the appendices must not exceed 4 pages.
